- A collaborative project:
 - 5 hospitals
 - 7 companies
 - 1 non-profit group of tracking experts
 - 3 scientific research institutions
 - Partly funded by French minister of economy, industry and employment
- Scope: tracking medical devices and containers
- A management goal : better processes
 - efficient allocation of resources for higher quality of medical care
 - risk management
 - compliance with regulations

Hospital expectations : an organizational perspective

- Taylor-made new processes
- Involvement of hospital staff:
 - Allows co-design
 - Should contribute to better adoption



Industrial expectations: a durable growth perspective

- Open large and consistent markets
 - Cooperation with hospitals should facilitate later selling
 - Large scale experimentation should facilitate later selling
 - Market of IS for sterilization is larger than others in the healthcare sector
- Open markets protected from off-shore low-cost competition
 - Technological barrier
 - Constraints related to the necessary availability of surgical instruments



Open questions about IT projects within hospitals

- Technology as an answer to organizational difficulties?
 - To obtain an organizational change
 - To overcome an organizational failure
- Innovation driven buy bottom-up experimentation rather than institutional legitimacy?
 - More reactivity for the project
 - More pressure on the involved staff
